Elementary Summer Enrichment Program 2019

Summer enrollment requires a 1/3 deposit with all applications to be applied to the last weeks of enrollment. **Families are financially responsible for all weeks enrolled.** This policy will ensure full summer enrollment to meet our summer budget. **Tuition is due each Monday.**

Our **Primary Enrichment Program** is offered to children ages **4-6** or students who have completed one year in our Primary Program. **Extended Day students graduating** to Elementary in the fall will apply to the **Primary Program.**

Our **Elementary Enrichment Program** is for children ages 7-12, who will have completed one year of AMS Elementary School or who will have completed the first grade in a public school system. If your child attends our Elementary Program, you will be notified of field trips that may require a 3:15 pick up. Please notify the staff if you have prior appointments that would conflict with field trips.

Once the office receives your summer application and deposit, acceptance is automatic unless we are full. **In the event we do not have an opening for summer weeks requested, you will be contacted immediately.** Please contact the office if you wish to be on a wait list for specific weeks that may be full.
